WSP Eligibility & Qualifications

To become a WSP Corpsmember or Team Leader, applicants must meet the following requirements. If you have questions, please email us at WSP.Recruiter@ccc.ca.gov.

- Be between 18 and 32 years of age (as of 10/1/2025)
- Possess a high school diploma or its equivalent
- Be a U.S. citizen, national, or lawful permanent resident alien of the U.S.
- Complete a National Service Criminal History Check
- Possess, or be willing to obtain, a California Driver's License with a clean driving record (No more than 2 points on CA driver's record)
- Have some experience in conducting watershed restoration, conducting environmental surveys, or analyzing scientific data
- Be interested in environmental education and volunteer management
- Be willing and able to relocate to the Placement Site community (relocation expenses are not provided)
- Can pass a pre-enrollment physical based on the [Corpsmember Position Analysis](#) (reasonable accommodation can be requested with appropriate documentation)
